### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 4, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

## A re-inspection will be made on May 6, 2011 at 1:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. 2nd Floor - Bedroom - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information. -Double hung egress window measured 20.5 inches height by 26.5 inches width openable space and has a glazed area of 8.2 square feet.

- 2nd Floor MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved 2. Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- Basement MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. -Repair outlet with reversed polarity.
- Basement MSFC 3404.3.4, SPLC 34.15 (1) Reduce and maintain the flammable or combustible liquids storage quantity in accordance with MSFC 2703.1.1(1) or other approved storage methods. -Remove gas can from building.
- Basement SPLC 34.11 (4), 34.34 (1), MPC 4515, MPC 326 Connect or cap the sewer 5. piping in accordance with the plumbing code. This work will require a permit. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989. -Contact a licensed plumber to install laundry sink drain to code.
- Bathroom SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4715.200.T Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms.
- Exterior Rear SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. (HN-1) -Provide reflective numbers or background or illuminate at night.
- Interior MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters. 8. -1st floor and 2nd floor.
- 9. Interior - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the window locks. -Where needed throughout.
- 10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 11. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
