

1 An Ordinance amending Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 18 to give authority to the
2 Legislative Hearing Officer to hear appeals regarding water bills, fees and other charges
3 imposed under the Water Code.

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5 THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL DOES ORDAIN:

7 Section 1.
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9 That chapter 18 of Saint Paul Legislative Code is hereby amended as follows:
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11 **Chapter 18. – Legislative Hearing Officer**
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13 Sec. 18.01 – Legislative hearing officer.

14 In order to hear and decide appeals of orders, decisions or determinations
15 made by the enforcement officers relative to the enforcement of health, housing,
16 building or fire codes contained in the Saint Paul Legislative Code, and in order to
17 hear appeals and make determinations relative to any violation, invoice, fee, or
18 shutoff imposed under the water code, safe pedestrian crossing areas under
19 section 156.05, and newsracks under chapter 131 of the Saint Paul Legislative
20 Code, there shall be and is hereby created a legislative hearing officer. The
21 legislative hearing officer shall be a city employee appointed by the president of
22 the city council. The legislative hearing officer shall have the authority to hear
23 appeals to orders, decisions or determinations of the enforcement officers or
24 others and make recommendations to the city council or the Board of Water
25 Commissioners. The hearing officer shall not have the power to grant waivers of
26 the Minnesota State Building Code. All matters, orders, decisions,
27 recommendations, and determinations of the hearing officer shall be forwarded to
28 the city council or the Board of Water Commissioners in resolution form within
29 ten (10) days of the hearing officer's actions. The city council or Board of Water
30 Commissioners shall have the authority to approve, modify, reverse, revoke,
31 wholly or partly, the hearing officer's orders, decisions, recommendations or
32 determinations and shall make such order, decision or determination as ought to
33 be made. All matters, orders, decisions and determinations of the hearing officer,
34 being recommendations to the city council, are not subject to judicial review.

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38 All other sections of Chapter 18 shall remain unchanged.
