NARRATIVE

On 12/26/12 at 0444 hours, we (sqd. 215t SMITH/ONNEN) were driving south on Rice St. and noticed a broken window at 911 Rice St. The broken window was on the northeast corner of the building, and we also noticed a brick inside the building near the window. We secured the perimeter on the building with sqd. 218, and K9 (sqd. 636 BUTH).

We had to break the window further in order to safely gain entry into the building. K9 and Officer Onnen made entry into the building and conducted a search with negative results. Upon further searching we noticed another open door at 917 Rice St. We made entry and found an employee of the business (RONALD RICHARD 05/16/72 1120 LEALAND RD. MAPLEWOOD, MN 55109 refused to give phone number) who stated that he noticed the broken window at 0430 hours when he arrived. RICHARD stated that he didn't call the police because it wasn't his business.

We notified the Data channel to have the window boarded up, and sqd. 218 met with the business owner (VANG, KONG MENG 04/28/84 1190 FRANCE CT. MAPLEWOOD, MN 55109 651-734-2095). VANG stated that he was not sure if anything was missing, and sqd. 218 gave him a green sheet to notify an investigator with any further information. I took photos of the scene, and did not notice any other items of evidentiary value.
