3. List your name as "plaintiff" and the seized property as "defendant" in the title of the complaint.
4. State the grounds on which you allege the property was improperly seized and what your ownership interest is in the property.

You do not have to pay the court filing fee if it is determined you cannot afford the fee. If the value of the seized property is \$7,500 or less, you can file an action in conciliation court to recover the property. If the value of the seized property is less than \$500, you do not have to pay the conciliation court filing fee.
