This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that a variance be issued to allow Central Corridor Light Rail construction between 6:00 AM and 12:00 midnight from March 8, 2012 to November 30, 2012.

Location: University Avenue from Hamline Avenue to Robert Street.
