Noise Source: Podium Sports Marketing Minnesota Half Marathon 2015 has applied for a sound level variance in order to present amplified music and announcements at the Southwest End of the Median on Shepard Road at Randolph Avenue. The Minnesota Half Marathon at the Southwest End of the Median on Shepard Road at Randolph Avenue is to be held on Saturday, August 1, 2015, from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for the Event on Saturday, August 1, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 11:00 a.m. on the date of the event.
