I would like to appeal the following order from the City of St Paul: item # 7 unit # 2-MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from the sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of operable height and 20 inches of open able width.

This is a stucco home and this window was there before I purchased the property. It only has enough space to put a double-hung window with the size of 15.5 inches openable height of 25 inches openable width. It is impossible to put a bigger size window or at the recommended size of window for this space without tearing down the stucco and other metal structures surrounding it. Therefore, I would like to ask for an exemption for this order.

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on May 25, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on June 21, 2011 at 11:00 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. EXTERIOR GARAGE SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Scrape and paint garage where needed in a professional manner.
- EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Repair damaged stucco on west side of house in a professional manner.
- EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.

- Of—4. INTERIOR BOTH UNITS SPLC 34.11 (4), 34.34 (1), MPC 4515, MPC 326 Connect or cap the plumbing piping in kitchen in accordance with the plumbing code.
- 5. INTERIOR BOTH UNITS SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-There is evidence of an infestation of roaches. Professionally exterminate and provide documentation to inspector.

6. INTERIOR - UNIT 1 - SPLC 34.12 (2), 34.35 (1) - Repair and maintain all required and Meching supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition.-Repair or replace damaged kitchen countertop around sink in a professional manner.

7. INTERIOR - UNIT 2 - MSEC1026: -

INTERIOR - UNIT 2 - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Upon inspection, double-hung window in east bedroom measured 15.5 inches openable height x 25 inches openable width.

INTERIOR - SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.-Contact DSI at 651-266-8989 for final inspection of permit.

9. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
