Hello Joanna,

Thank you for your message about the street light.

We have let the Public Works lighting division know so that they can address the issue as soon as they are able. The lighting division inspects all reports of damaged and nonworking street lights to make sure the fixture is safe and secure and there are no safety hazards to residents.

We appreciate the additional safety efforts taken by the property owner.

This light may still be out due to damage from wire theft. If the street light is not working due to wire theft, unfortunately, conduits are frozen and our team will not be able to rewire and fix these types of issues at this time. Because we cannot make repairs to frozen conduits until the ground thaws, it is likely that we will not get the street light working

Our Public Works lighting division is working with the Police Department to continue to try and reduce and prevent wire theft. We are also asking residents and businesses to be alert if they see people "working" on the street lights and there is not a City vehicle nearby to report it to the police.


