Noise Source: Alliance Francaise de Minneapolis/St. Paul has requested a sound level variance in order to present music and announcements at Landmark Plaza with a requested sound level limit of 95 decibels (dBA) at 100 feet on Sunday, July 10, 2016, from noon to 6:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 10:00 a.m. to noon. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for Alliance Francaise de Minneapolis/St. Paul at Landmark Plaza on July 10, 2016, from noon to 6:00 p.m. with a pre-event sound check from 10:00 a.m. to noon on July 10, 2016. 2) Noise source of operation for the event performances are noon to 6:00 p.m. on July 10, 2016. 3) All electronically powered equipment, PA system, loudspeaker or any similar device used in conjunction with the event, will not exceed 92 dBA, as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source used for music and/or announcements between the hours of noon and 6:00 p.m., and shall not exceed 75 dBA as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to noon. 4) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 5) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off by 6:00 p.m. on the day of the event.
