



Pangea's Covid Protocols: April 4th

Pangea World Theater Covid Statement:

Pangea World Theater's COVID-19 Protocols are shaped foremost by the fact that Covid-19 has disproportionately impacted the Indigenous people in the Twin Cities, greater Minnesota, and beyond. We are honored to work side-by-side on the sacred and traditional land of the Dakota people and commit to ensuring safety and security of those most impacted during this pandemic.

Our protocols do not adhere to an industry standard set by institutions that try to balance human lives against profit margins. The following protocols are crafted with the rigor needed to protect Indigenous, Black and Brown communities, and the most vulnerable members of our circle.

Guidelines for Rehearsals:

Rehearsal:

1. All rehearsals consisting of more than 2 people will take place outside
2. Any cast members traveling from outside of the state must provide a negative covid test before departure and 4 days after arrival.
3. Any cast members traveling from outside of the state will be asked to quarantine for at least 1 week after arrival before joining the cast.
4. All cast members are asked to pod together and limit exposure to others while in the rehearsal, tech and performance process.
5. All cast members are asked to have received the last shot of the Covid 19 vaccine at least 2 weeks prior to the first in person rehearsal.
6. During rehearsals all artist and production staff involved will be required to wear masks.
7. Masks, gloves and hand sanitizer will be provided by production staff during all rehearsals, performances and gatherings
8. All artists and production staff are asked to review the following questions before they start each rehearsal. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms, do not attend rehearsal and get tested at the nearest testing site. <https://mn.gov/covid19/get-tested/testing-locations/index.jsp>
 - Are you experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms?
 - **fever (99.5+ measured *or* just feeling feverish)**
 - **cough**
 - **shortness of breath**
 - **sore throat**

9. During rehearsal, artists and production staff are asked to keep at least a 6 foot distance from each other and keep social distance at all times
10. All technical equipment, chairs, tables, and any other shared equipment will be sanitized after each use

Guidelines for Audience Members During Outdoor Events:

When you arrive at a Pangea Event:

Please check in at the Box Office. There you will find hand sanitizer and masks for your use.

- Pangea World Theater requires you to wear a mask when attending our public gatherings and events. If you refuse to wear a mask you will be asked to leave.
- Audience members who are from different households must maintain 6 feet of distance or more.
- Bright colored markings will be placed on the ground to indicate social distancing.
- Pangea's ushers will also support our guests in maintaining a social distance and following Covid safety protocols while attending the event.
- If any audience member is experiencing the following symptoms please stay home and get tested at the nearest testing site <https://mn.gov/covid19/get-tested/testing-locations/index.jsp>. All audience members will be asked the following:
 - **Are you experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms?**
 - **fever (99.5+ measured *or* just feeling feverish)**

Guidelines for Pangea Offices and Pangea Studios:

As of April 13, 2021:

Before coming to Pangea: Contact Office Manager to verify schedule time (We want to make sure there are not too many people at one time and to ensure safety)

What Pangea staff is expected to do while at the spaces and before leaving:

- When in the office and studio space, staff members:
 - Wear a mask at all times
 - Disinfect door knobs before leaving
 - Disinfect and wipe down all surfaces that have been used before leaving the space
 - Take out any trash
 - Turn on fans and open windows for proper air circulation if possible (When do they do this??)

What our guest are asked (expected) to do:

- Before entering Pangea's studio or offices we ask that guests go through the following checklist. If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms please stay home and get tested at the nearest testing site <https://mn.gov/covid19/get-tested/testing-locations/index.jsp>
 - **fever (99.5+ measured *or* just feeling feverish)**
 - cough**
 - shortness of breath**
 - sore throat**
 - loss of taste/smell**
 - chills**
 - headache**
 - muscle pain**
 - sore throat**
- When entering and exiting the office and studio space you will find a bottle of disinfectant and a roll of paper towels. We ask that you disinfect anything you have used in the room, (chairs, tables, pens, ect)
- Wear a mask at all times
- No more than 2 people in any office or studio space
