- 1. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 2. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door frame.-Repair door frame on back door in a professional manner. Provide door knob for back door.
- 3. INTERIOR SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-It has been reported that there is an infestation of mice. Professionally exterminate and provide documentation to inspector.

- 4. INTERIOR MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Upon inspection, double-hung window in first floor bedroom measured 33 inches openable height x 18.5 inches openable width. Double-hung window in south upstairs bedroom measured 19.5 inches openable height x 27 inches openable width.
- 5. INTERIOR MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Make window in north upstairs bedroom openable within 24 hours.
- 6. INTERIOR SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Repair water damaged ceiling in living room in a professional manner.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
