Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 4, 2010. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on November 4, 2010 at 1:45pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - Bathroom - SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4715.200.T - Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms.-Contact DSI at 651-266-8989 to obtain a permits for the vent fan that has been installed.

2. Egress Windows - Main Floor Bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Main Floor Southeast Bedroom (Double-hung)

17 h x 34 w - Openable 33 h x 32 w - Glazed

Note: Contact Window World to have building inspector final the open permit for the window that has been replaced.

Main Floor Southwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

17.5 h x 37 w - Openable 41 h x 36 w - Glazed

Note: Contact Window World to have building inspector final the open permit for the window that has been replaced.

Main Floor Northwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

20h x 37w - Openable 41h x 36w - Glazed

- 3. Main Floor Northwest Bedroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Replace the broken window pane.
- 4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
