Your building was inspected on October 5, 2010 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on November 5, 2010 at 1:45pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Northeast Room SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.
- 2. Basement Northeast Room Closet MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.

3. Egress Window - Main Floor Northwest Bedroom - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.

Main Floor Northwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

20.5h x 29w - Openable 41h x 28w - Glazed

- 4. Garage MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 5. Main Floor East Entry Door SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.
- 6. Main Floor Garage Entry Door MSFC 703.1 Repair and maintain the required occupancy separation with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Provide an automatic door closer on the door between the attached garage and the house.
- 7. Main Floor Kitchen NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-Remove and discontinue the use of a power-strip to supply power to the microwave oven. Microwave ovens must be plugged directly into a permanent outlet.
