Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on November 22, 2019. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on December 30, 2019 at 1:40 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Garage SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. -Per the Building Inspector's observation, you must have an engineer evaluate the garage and submit a report to this office. The interior part of the garage has been involved in an unreported fire and unapproved work has been done.
- 2. Exterior Gutters SPLC 34.08 (2) Grading and drainage. All premises shall be graded and maintained to drain water away from structures and minimize the accumulation of water on such premises. Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. There are sections of the gutter that has disconnected and has parts missing.

- 3. Exterior House SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. -The house has different spots that have peeling paint.
- 4. Exterior Near Garage SPLC 45.03 (7) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall. -The tree is rubbing against the garage and is damaging the shingles.
- 5. Unit 2 Kitchen MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing. -The amp outlet in the kitchen is missing the cover.
- 6. MSBC -Section 105.1 Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit. A permit is required for the installation of the 20-amp outlet in the basement that is connected to the electrical panel. No permit has been pulled.
 A permit is required for the installation of the new bedroom door and door frame in Unit 2.
