NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance – Team Ortho Foundation Get Lucky Run March 12, 2016

TO: CapitolRiver Council District 17

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: Sibley Street from Kellogg Boulevard to Shepard Road

Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested a sound level variance to provide the use of a sound system for announcements on Sibley Street from Kellogg Boulevard to Shepard Road for the 2016 Get Lucky Run. The variance is requested for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 12, 2016.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) the variance shall be for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for the Get Lucky Run Event on Saturday, March 12, 2016. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 12:30 p.m. on the date of the event.
