This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending that a variance be issued to you in order to provide amplified music and the use of a sound system outdoors, at a recommended sound level limit of 95 decibels (dBA) at a distance of 50 feet from the sound source, from 7:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 29, 2016, at Raspberry Island.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **Wednesday, July 6, 2016, at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
