### NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE LICENSE

RE: Taxicab Vehicle license for Cab #503 held by Malik Olaad d/b/a Town Taxi & Transportation for the City of Saint Paul  
License ID #: 20090005000

Dear Malik Olaad:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend revocation of the Taxicab Vehicle license for Cab #503 held by Malik Olaad d/b/a Town Taxi & Transportation for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

**On April 13, 2011, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating that your Taxicab Vehicle license for Cab #503 expired as of November 22, 2010 and had not met the renewal requirements because you had not submitted the following: 1) a current Mechanical Inspection and 2) a completed Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law form.**

**Failure to obtain an annual mechanical inspection is a violation of Saint Paul Legislative Code § 376.12 (h) (1) which states: "Any taxicab owner shall submit each and every licensed taxicab to an annual inspection. The schedule for such inspections shall be maintained by the licensed inspector. The inspections shall be carried out at the fire/police equipment services garage located at 1675 Kasota Street, Saint Paul, at a cost to be established by the city garage and approved by the license inspector to be paid by the licensee....."**

At this time, you have two options on how to proceed:

1. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by **Monday, May 30, 2011**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to revoke your license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

2. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation. If this is your choice, please advise me no later than **Monday, May 30, 2011**, and I will take the necessary steps to schedule the administrative hearing.

**If you have not contacted me by Monday, May 30, 2011, I will assume that you do not contest the revocation of your license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.**




