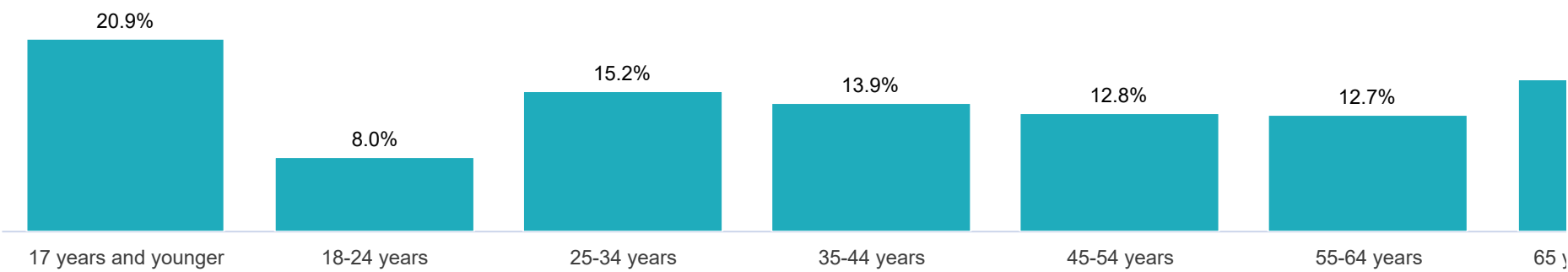


Highland neighborhood, population by age group

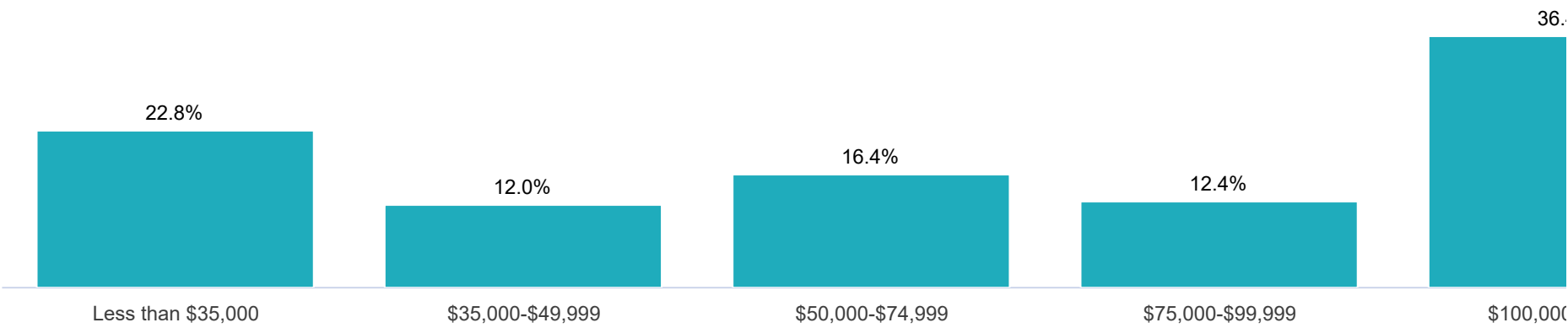

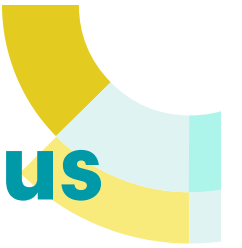

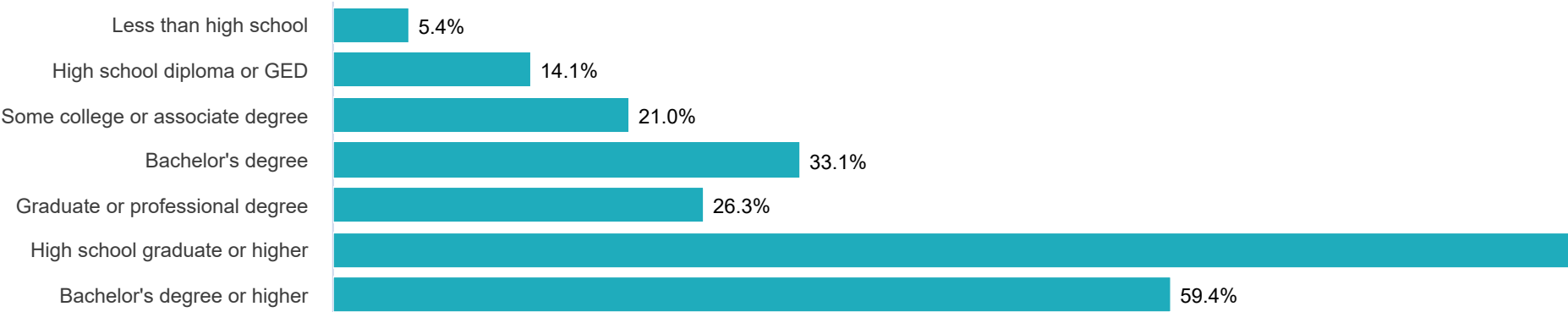
