#### SUMMARY OF ENGINEERING RECOMMENDATION

#### **Kent Street New Sidewalk Construction**

#### **PROJECT**:

This project is to complete the city sidewalk on the west side of **Kent Street between West Orange Avenue and West Wheelock Parkway.** The new sidewalk is approximately 580' long and will be constructed in front of ten properties. This sidewalk construction to be done as part of the Arlington/Rice RSVP Project.

### **EXISTING CONDITIONS:**

There is one property with an existing sidewalk. The area where the sidewalk is to be constructed abutting is basically flat with some trees of various sizes.

# **INITIATING ACTION:**

This order was initiated by local residents with a petition. They are asking for the sidewalk to be completed due to pedestrian safety in the neighborhood.

### **ALTERNATES:**

Do nothing and this will stay an incomplete walk where pedestrians will need to use the street.

### **POSITIVE BENFITS:**

The people who live in the area will get an opportunity to use a city sidewalk where motorize traffic has been an issue.

### **ADVERSE EFFECTS**

Normal problems associated with construction such as noise, dust, and general disruption to the neighborhood. There will a direct assessment to all ten abutting properties so there may be some property owners contesting the new walk whom did not sign the petition.

#### **EFFECTS ON TREES:**

There may be some boulevard trees that will need to be removed for the new sidewalk.

#### **TIME SCHEDULE:**

The project to be done during the 2013 Arlington/Rice RSVP project.
