 15 online training program, the EVOC 101 (Emergency Vehicle Operations Course) in which all officers
 16 would be able to participate focusing on street and intersection safety training; and

Dear Chief Smith:

The Police Foundation Board of Directors has approved a grant of \$13,109.00 to the Saint Paul Police Department, as recommended by the 100 Club Committee.

Included with this letter is a check in the amount of \$13,109.00, and, a copy of the 100 Club Committee's April 27th meeting minutes, which outlines the approved use of these funds. Specifically, the grant to Saint Paul Police Department is to provide:

- \$10,500 to purchase the EVOC 101 Emergency Vehicle Operations Course, a training program in which all officers will be able to participate in online street and intersection safety training, and,
- \$2,609 to be used towards the purchase of tactical vests and helmets for district force units - intended to improve the safety of our officers in executing search warrants.

For the purpose of evaluating this grant, we request a written report be submitted to the Police Foundation no later than Dec. 31, 2011, that outlines how these funds were spent and the impact this investment has made in improving the safety of Saint Paul's police officers. In communicating information about these projects within the department or community, it is appropriate to indicate that funding was made possible through the Saint Paul Police Foundation 100 Club Committee.
