

Twins Community Fund Youth Baseball Coaching Grant Application Section 2 – Grant Information

- 1. Our goal is to provide 4 coaches, one for each of our 4 teams, with a stipend using this grant. Each coach will receive a \$400.00 stipend. Job description attached. Prior to the first game, coaches will complete a Background Check form and attend a three hour St. Paul Parks and Recreation's Youth Coaches Clinic. Teams will practice twice a week, two hours each session, beginning May 9, for 3 weeks. Each team will play a game once a week and practice once a week for 8 weeks. Each coach will devote a minimum of 47 hours attending clinics, practicing and at games.
- 2. Currently we do not pay coaches, unless recreation staff are needed to coach in which case they are paid their hourly wage. It is difficult to find volunteer coaches for baseball and softball at Scheffer. Most of the parents and volunteers are interested in helping coach the football and basketball teams the sports in which they are most knowledgeable. We have many well-intentioned parents at Scheffer, unfortunately there are quite a few who are ineligible to coach because they are unable to pass a Background Check. If awarded, this grant will help us to establish a baseball and softball program for Scheffer area youth. Our goal is to introduce/acclimate parents to baseball and softball with the hope that they will become knowledgeable enough to coach. Another goal is to teach our players fundamental skills so that they can someday also coach youth baseball and softball.
- 3. We will recruit high school and/or college students to coach through the local schools coaches and Athletic Directors (Como and Central Senior High Schools) and Saint Paul Colleges and Universities (Tom Cross Macalester College, John Tschida St. Thomas University, Tim Gormley Augsburg College, Tom Ruebelke Hamline University).
