This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

You requested a variance to allow you to present amplified music during an anniversary party at 845 Albemarle Street, between 5:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight on August 10, 2013. The recommendation is for a noise limit of 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from exterior of tent opening from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and a noise limit of 75 dBA as measured from the exterior of the tent opening from 10:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **July 10, 2013**, **5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.
