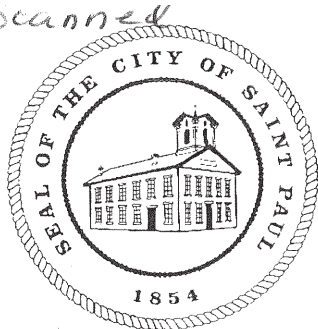

A re-inspection was made on your building on September 28, 2012, in response to a complaint. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected prior to re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on October 8, 2012 at 2:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Unit 305 - Condemned - Bedbugs - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - Unit 305 is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This unit must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. **-This unit is condemned due to an extreme case of bedbugs. Immediately perform the prep work required by the licensed exterminating company the property management has hired to treat the unit or vacate this unit. Failure to comply will result in enforcement action.**
2. Unit 305 - Exterminate - SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) - Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination. **-The exterminating company found bedbugs throughout unit 305. The inspector has confirmed the presence of bedbugs in the unit. Contact licensed exterminator to treat unit 305 for bed bugs. Provide the inspector documentation of the treatment and follow-up visits.**

3. Unit 305 - SPLC 34.20 - Every occupant of buildings, dwelling units, guest rooms, habitable rooms, premises, residential structures, rooming houses, rooming units, and other structures or premises shall upon receiving reasonable prior notice give the owner or operator or their agent or employee access to the premises at reasonable times for the purposes of effecting inspections, maintenance, repairs or alterations which are necessary to comply with provisions of this chapter. **-Provide the management staff, exterminator, and other relevant personnel access to unit 305 for the purpose of exterminating the unit of bedbugs.**
