### Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 992 HATCH AVE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 16, 2014; for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

### As re-inspection will be made on November 3, 2014 at 9:30 am or the property vacateds

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Basement MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Repair or replace the damaged light fixture near the wash machine.
- Basement SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 4715.0200.C Repair the laundry tub in the basement. Repair the laundry tub that is clogged.
- 3. Basement/Throughout MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters. Property manager removed from the basement on site.
- 4. Egress Windows MSFC 1028.3 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit way. The bedroom egress windows are blocked by a cedar fence. Remove the fence near the egress windows for escape.

- 5. Interior Basement SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office. The information provided states the system does not operate safely. Repair or replace.
- 6. Interior Basement MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Replace the dryer vent to meet code. Permit required.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
