Your building was inspected on February 23, 2017 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on March 31, 2017 at 9:30 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Interior Above Furnace MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.Junction box missing cover.
- 2. Interior Basement Bathroom SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4714.01 (T) Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms. This will require a licensed contractor to obtain permits for electrical work and a warm-air ventilation duct permit.-

Basement bathroom has no window and no bath fan.

3. Interior - Basement Sleeping Room Egress Window - SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) - Repair and maintain the window lock.-

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- 4. Interior Gas Fireplace MSFC 603.6 Have the chimneys, fireplaces, and vents inspected for soundness, freedom from deposits, and correct clearances. Cleaning, maintenance, and repairs shall be done if indicated by the inspection.Originally, a gas fireplace installed under permit, no inspection of work or approval of installation, permit was closed without approval. Ideally, a new permit would be obtained by the original installer to have the work approved. Chimney and vent are subject to inspection for the above requirements.
- 5. Interior Sleeping Room MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters. Sara's sleeping room using multi-plug adapters, use surge protected devices. One at outlet by gas fire place.
