I am writing a statement to be added to the agenda of the public hearing on Wed, Nov 7, 2018 in regards to the 2018 Street Maintenance Service Program fees for Lighting and Sweeping (Assessment #180025).

My issue I would like to be heard is regarding the ticketing and towing of cars illegally parked on the street during the time of street sweeping. During the spring time street sweeping session, a car that did not belong to me (or anyone in my home) was parked in front of my house and was not ticketed or towed before the sweepers came. This meant the sweepers complained to me about a vehicle that I didn't own or have any control over, and also meant that my house did not receive the street sweeping service I was billed for. I would like my \$19 sweeping fee absorbed by the city because it is the city's responsibility to enforce "no parking" rules.
