Noise Source: Jennifer Williams, Anderson Race Management, Director of Events, has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 100 dBA at no specified distance from the sound source, to present amplified sound with use of a sound system for their PrairieCare 5K Run Walk Event on June 10, 2023 at Phalen Park Pavilion. The variance is requested for the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., with a sound check at 7:45 a.m. on Saturday, June 10, 2023. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a sound check at 7:45a.m. on Saturday, June 10, 2023, for the PrairieCare 5K Run Walk event, at Phalen Park Pavilion. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources on June 10, 2023. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on June 10, 2023.

Submit comments for Public Hearing electronically. The public may comment on public hearing items in person, in writing or via voicemail. Any comments and materials submitted by 12:00 pm of the day before the meeting, Tuesday, June 6, 2023, will be attached to the public record and available for review by the City Council.
