Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 15, 2010. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

## A re-inspection will be made on or after November 5, 2010.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

- Main Floor Furnace Room MFGC 503 Provide, repair or replace the fuel equipment vent or vent liner to develop a positive flow adequate to convey all products of combustion to the outside. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Obtain a mechanical permit for the replacement of the water heater vent that was replaced. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989.
- 2. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
