Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested a sound level variance to provide the use of a sound system for Post- Race Announcements at the Shepard Road and Jackson Street Finish for the 2015 Get Lucky Run. The variance is requested for the hours of 9:30 a.m.to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 14, 2015.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for the Get Lucky Run Finish Event on Saturday, March 14, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
