I am confused about the switch from Aspen Waste Management to the City of St. Paul. I was away from my home and did not receive service. Now I wish to restart service. What is the procedure? Can I simply restart payments via the online portal? Do I have to pay for service I did not receive (because I was away from my home until today)? Can I utilize the old Aspen Waste Management garbage bin? If I leave a foam cushion outside of the bin, could you please pick this up in addition to the contents of the bin?

Hello Stuart,

As of April 1, 2025, the City of Saint Paul began a new garbage hauling contract for homes with 1-4-units. About 90 percent of households have their garbage picked up by a new hauler, called FCC Environmental Services. The other 10 percent are serviced by the City of Saint Paul.

Here is a summary of what you need to know as a resident or homeowner:

**Collection Day:** There has been no change in your garbage or recycling collection day. The time of your collection might have changed. Please make sure carts out by 6 AM as they may be picked up as late as 6 PM. You can continue using your same garbage cart that you have now.

**Billing:** Garbage billing is now handled through the City of Saint Paul Assessments Office. Bills will be mailed quarterly in the month following a service period. Garbage bills are mailed quarterly to the mailing address on file with Ramsey County for the property owner. Additional billing details are available at [stpaul.gov/garbagerates](http://stpaul.gov/garbagerates).

**Bulky Items:** Households can now have 1 bulky item collected per dwelling unit per calendar month. Pickups must still be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance and will happen on your usual garbage collection day. Find out more at [stpaul.gov/bulky](http://stpaul.gov/bulky).

**Customer Service:** All customer service needs for solid waste and recycling are now handled by the City. This includes missed collection reports, billing questions, cart repairs, and all other waste-related inquiries. To reach us, reply to this email or use one of the following:

Hi Stuart

Thanks for reaching out about your garbage bill with the City of Saint Paul.

- Quarter 2: The charges for Quarter 2 must go to a Legislative Hearing on November 13. We have enough information to recommend the bill's removal, but please know I cannot guarantee the outcome.
- Quarter 3: Once the Quarter 2 decision is final, we can recommend the same action for the Quarter 3 bill without needing another hearing.

I have a few questions:

1. You will need a city branded cart. I can have that swapped out for you. The small (35 gallon) cart is now \$82.69 per quarter. Do you still have the Aspen cart, and need the city cart delivered?

2. Do you still need the foam cushion to be picked up?
3. Did you want to attend the legislative hearing on November 13? Your attendance is not required. The hearing will be between 9am and 11am, and we would call you via phone if you plan on attending.

Jillian,

I greatly appreciate your note, thank you!

1. Yes, I have the Aspen cart. It is in the alley behind my home, so it is ready to be swapped for the city cart.
2. Someone scavenged the foam cushion, so I already canceled the bulky item pickup.
3. I will not attend the hearing if my attendance is not required.
4. I believe the overdue charges will be transferred to Ramsey county mid-November and a late fee will be applied. Should I go ahead and pay the charges and await the outcome of the hearing? I presume that I would receive a credit if the overdue charges are dismissed.
5. I presume that I only need to restart auto payments to receive service going forward--correct?

Hi Stuart

I will set up a cart swap to happen in the next couple days. We usually do swaps on your collection day but because you have an Aspen cart, I am going to try and push to get you a cart before collection day to ensure you are collected next week.

The overdue charges are typically set to transfer to Ramsey County on November 15, but we asked for an extension this year. If you pay the assessment, then there is nothing to contest. If you make a payment, it means you agree to the charges. I would wait until after the hearing to make a payment. The balance will not transfer until December 19.

You can set up autopay with the city moving forward. There will be instructions on how to set that up on your next bill, along with the access code needed to set up an account.
