RE: RE-INSPECTION FIRE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY WITH DEFICIENCIES 1324 ST CLAIR AVE

## Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on May 25, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on July 12, 2011 at 10:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This basement is condemned as unsafe or dangerous as a sleeping area. This basement must not be used as a sleeping area until reinspected and approved by this office.-Immediately remove all beds and bedding from the basement. This basement is not a legal sleeping area.
- 2. Basement stove MFGC 409.5 Provide an approved gas shut off valve within 6 feet of the appliance in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 3. Double hung windows MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-First floor north 22 h x 29 w Glazed 8.7 sq ft

Second floor south

17 h x 29 w Glazed 5.8 sq ft Second floor north 15 h x 29 w Glazed 5.1 sq ft

- 4. Garage and house SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Scrape and remove chipped and peeling paint. Repaint in a professional manner.
- 5. Porch MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 6. Porch MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 7. Porch MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Reduce storage on the porch by 50 percent.
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 9. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Immediately provide approved alarms.
- 10. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 11. Provide the inspector with a completed and signed Residential Occupancy Affidavit.
