For all applications - General Liability Certificate of Insurance specifically extending coverage to the sidewalk café and naming the City of St Paul as an additional insured. Minimum liability insurance coverage must be \$500,000*

For all applications - Sidewalk Seating Site Plan for the table, seating, fencing, etc. layout*

Public Works Right - of - Way Obstruction Permit

Public Works must approve the public sidewalk seating area before this license can be approved. You are required to pay an additional fee for an Obstruction Permit to place tables and chairs in the public right-of-way. The permit fee of \$60.00 is collected at time of initial license application, and at the beginning of each year thereafter. This is in addition to the license renewal process. Payment of all fees related to placing tables and chairs in the public right-of-way are submitted to DSI.



To whom it may concern:

This letter is to request the addition of an Outdoor Service Area (private patio) endorsement to our existing liquor license. As preparation of this request, we installed out door video cameras that can be viewed by managers & staff to control who comes and goes on the patio. We will also have rope style portable stanchions and food runners continually in the area to monitor and ensure there is no minor alcohol consumption, and that alcohol does not leave the patio area.

The proposed hours of operation are no earlier or later than 9am – 12am, Sunday through Saturday. We are a counter service restaurant; therefore customers must come into the restaurant to order food and beverages, including beer and wine. Our runners will bring out all food and alcohol. Because we are also a self bussing establishment, meaning we also do not have anyone dedicated to clearing tables. We serve all of our food and drinks on and in disposable plates and cups.

We appreciate your consideration of our patio to the current liquor license.
