## Sound Level Variance Application Lowertown Bike Shop Music Event, East Parking lot of Jax Building, 253 4th Street East

**Event:** Lowertown Bike Shop Music Event

**Description of Variance:**

**Location:** Event will be located outdoors at the East Parking lot of the Jax Building, 253 4<sup>th</sup> Street East

**Noise Source:** The Lowertown Bike Shop has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide outdoor music at the East Parking Lot of the Jax Building, 253 4<sup>th</sup> Street East during their Music Event on Sunday, September 28, 2014 from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. for amplified music, and unamplified music from 7:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. for a live band outdoors on Sunday, September 28, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for amplified music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 28, 2014.
