Your building was inspected on October 8, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on November 8, 2012 at 11:30A.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.- After securing the toilet to the floor caulk the base.
- 2. Basement SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-There is no emergency escape from the sleeping area in the basement. Remove bed and mattresses from the basement.
- 3. Basement SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and An Equal Opportunity Employer

maintain an approved private toilet. The toilet downstairs is loose and has to be secured to the floor.

- 4. House SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Paint the wall. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls. There are holes in the walls in the house that have to be repaired.
- 5. Kitchen SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the floor tile. Repair all torn or missing floor tile.
- 6. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office. You can obtain this form on the web page.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
