An attempt to re-inspect unit 10 of the above-referenced building for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy was made on December 5, 2019. The tenant failed to allow access for inspection and the unit occupancy has been revoked. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on January 6, 2020 at 12:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

- 2. Interior Unit 10 Storage Space SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.34(1) Repair and maintain the damaged structural member. This repair requires a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
 - 11/19/19: received September 27 evaluation from property manager regarding space. Provide a timeline for the addressing of the space including permit application with plan to be reviewed by Fire Safety Inspections and City Building Engineering. Include addressing the decision of repairing or filling in of the space. The city engineer may accompany fire inspections on next inspection for evaluation of the space. Appears there may be structural damage from water leaking into space. Steel beams in space are rusting. Once the water no longer is entering the space, an evaluation by a structural engineer will need to be done to verify the structural integrity of the building/space.
- 3. Interior Unit 10 Storage Space SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.

 Standing water on floor, water dripping/pouring from ceiling, metal ceiling supports rusted and corroded. Parts of wall or ceiling have fallen to floor.
- 4. Interior Unit 10 Fireplace MSFC 603.6 Have the chimneys, fireplaces, and vents inspected for soundness, freedom from deposits, and correct clearances. Cleaning, maintenance, and repairs shall be done if indicated by the inspection.
