Description of Variance

Location: Event will be located outdoors at Union Depot, North Plaza, 214 4th Street East

Noise Source: Tina Volpe, Marketing Manager has applied for a sound level variance in order to present outdoor High School Marching Band and Drumline performances at Union Depot North Plaza on Thursday, May 21, 2015. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for outdoor High School Marching Band and Drumline performances for the hours from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 21, 2015, with a pre-event sound check at 4:30 p.m.. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 90 dBA, as measured at 50 feet from the noise source from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 4:30 p.m. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who will provide sound level monitoring to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 21, 2015.
