#### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 14, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on April 13, 2011 at 2:00 pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Unit 3 Entry Door MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Remove surface-bolt lock.
- 2. Unit 4 Bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Existing double-hung window does not meet openable height

requirement. Window has an openable area of 20 inches high by 35.5 inches wide and a glazed area of 49 inches high by 35.5 inches wide, 12.1 square feet.

- 3. Unit 4 Front and Rear Entry Doors MSFC 703 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly.-Repair and maintain the door closer.
- 4. Unit 5 Bathroom SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair shut-off valve with missing/broken handle on tub supply line.
- 5. Unit 5 Rear Entry Door MSFC 703 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly.-Repair and maintain the door closer.
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
