### Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

#### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 14, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on February 14, 2011 at 10:00 am or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement MFGC Chapter 4 Provide or replace fuel equipment piping in compliance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Re-pipe water heater gas supply lines in an approved manner. This work will require a permit(s). Contact DSI at (651)266-8989.
- 2. Basement MFGC 503 Provide, repair or replace the fuel equipment vent or vent liner to develop a positive flow adequate to convey all products of combustion to the outside. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Replace corroded vent elbow on water heater venting. This work will require a permit and inspection. Contact DSI at (651)266-8989.
- 3. Unit 3 SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-Property was illegally conformed into a triplex and does not meet zoning or code requirements of a legal triplex.

- 4. SPLC 62.101 Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use. Discontinue:-Discontinue use of property as an unapproved 3-unit residential occupancy. This work will require permit(s) and may require plans to be submitted. Contact DSI at (651) 266-8989.

  Third floor must be approved or de-converted.
- 5. SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-Provide documentation of extermination for mice.
- 6. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-Provide access for re-inspection on February 14, 2011 at 10:00 am.
- 7. Remove the accumulation of snow or ice from the public and private sidewalk abutting this property.

I would like to appeal the fire code deficiency requested, due to unfair treatment, I would like to have variance for water heaters to be grandfathered in, because they are working just fine, when I purchased this property (2006), they were installed and we have had inspections with you before and they are were never made mention that they had to be upgraded.

The first time that inspector Mitch Imbertson came out he told me that I had to have smoke detectors done, carbon monoxide detectors, fire exstinghers, I check electrical in basement, have furnaces checked and to have drip tee's checked on water heaters, I did and plumber that came out told me that one water heater was ok and the other one just needed an adjustment, so I paid the company and the work was done and I faxed all papers to him(electrical, furnace test, and water heater drip tee repair).

After that, I got another notice that he needed to get back in due to water heaters needed gas lines to make sure that gas lines, were separated, etc.. on water heaters.

I would like to put in a complaint that he should told me everything that needed to be done on the water heaters the first time, for this reason I feel singled out for no reason, and once his attitude was rude, so I would like to request a different inspector.
