### NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on September 4, 2014.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

#### A reinspection will be made on September 26, 2014 at 1:00 PM.

#### CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.
- 2. Front entry door SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.

- 3. House SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. ALL WOOD exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 4. Interior Basement NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.
- 5. Interior Kitchen SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. Repair or replace broken kitchen cabinets.
- 6. Interior Multiple Locations MSFC 315.2.5 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operator or repaired within a building. Remove lawn mower from front porch, and remove gas powered boat motors from the basement.
- 7. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.- Restore electric service to unit.
- 8. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-
- 9. Interior SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. -Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls. Paint the wall.
- 10. Main floor toilet SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor. After securing toilet to floor caulk the base.
- 11. Rear Deck Front Steps and Steps East Side of Building SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the damaged guardrail in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 12. Rear of Property SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.
- 13. Rear of Property SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property. You have and unlicensed boat in the rear yard.
- 14. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

- 15. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 16. SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-There are holes in your fascia that must be repaired
