Dear Ms. Bump:

You have requested permission to sell and serve Wine and Strong Beer and have wine sampling at the St. Paul Winter Carnival events taking place at Rice Park on: Thursday January 23rd from 5:30 – 9:00 p.m.; Friday January 24th (4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.); Saturday January 25th (12:00 p.m. – 9:00p.m.); Sunday January 26th (12:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.); Thursday January 30th (5:00 p.m. – 7:00p.m.); Friday January 31st (4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.); Saturday February 1st (12:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.); and Sunday February 2nd (12:00 p.m. – 5:00p.m.).

This letter will serve as confirmation that such permission has been given, subject to all of the conditions set forth below:

- Sales and service of alcohol must end ½ hour prior to end of event.
- The applicable liquor license must be obtained from and verified by the City of Saint Paul Department of Safety and Inspections, 651-266-8989.
- One (1) City of Saint Paul police officer is hired for all hours of the event with the cost being the responsibility of the event. The police officer must be hired by contacting Sgt. John Keating, City of Saint Paul Police Department, 651-266-5485.
- **Only two (2) drinks per sale.**
- **Servers and volunteers are not allowed to consume alcohol while dispensing alcoholic beverages.**
- Please be advised that Minn. Stat. S340A.909 requires that a Minnesota-produced beer be available for purchase at each station where beer is sold.
