I am appealing the low ceiling height for one of the bedroom at our property. The reason I am appealing is because I believe that the bedroom does not pose any hazardous living condition. The bedroom size is approximately 10 feet by 8 feet. It has an egress window which is easily accessible and there is adequate ventilation. We installed a smoke detector inside the bedroom and also a carbon monoxide detector within 10 feet of it. This bedroom ceiling is a few inches short of the standard height. Other than that, there is nothing else of concern.

This house was built in 1925; any structure change to remedy the low ceiling height does not seem to be possible. Please consider granting a variance for the ceiling height. Thank you for your time and consideration.
