Conditions are as follows:

1. This license shall not permit the sale of the following: distilled spirits in containers of 50 milliliters or less (miniatures), distilled spirits in half pint containers, fortified beers or wines, or single service containers of malt liquor (including 40oz bottles).
2. Per State of Minnesota Statute 340A.412, Subd. 14) - a liquor store may sell only the following items: (1) alcoholic beverages; (2) tobacco products; (3) ice; (4) beverages for mixing with intoxicating liquor; (5) soft drinks; (6) liqueur-filled candies; (7) food products that contain more than one-half of one percent alcohol by volume; (8) cork extraction devices; (9) books and videos on the use of alcoholic beverages; (10) magazines and other publications published primarily for information and education on alcoholic beverages; and (11) home brewing equipment.
3. No more than 50% of the storefront windows may be covered with any type of signage (e.g., advertisement, store hours, no loitering, etc.).
4. Licensee agrees to maintain window signage in compliance with Chapter 64 Zoning Code-Signs, which includes requirements such as, but not necessarily limited to the following: window signs placed between the height of four (4) to seven (7) above grade shall not block views into the cashier area and cannot cover more than thirty (30) percent of this window space area.
5. There shall be no obstruction of any kind on the entry door glass area.
6. Licensee must post on the exterior of the building, or in the store front windows, signage which is visible from the exterior and clearly states that no loitering is allowed.
