NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Kellogg Craft Beer Overlook September 2016 Sound Level Variance

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

<u>Locations</u>: Kellogg Craft Beer Overlook Event will be located outdoors at Kellogg Park, between Wabasha and Robert at the intersection of Cedar and Kellogg Boulevard

Noise Source: Brian Horst, Music In Mears LLC, has applied for a sound level variance, at a specified sound level limit of 80 dBA at no specified distance, in order to provide music outdoors at the Kellogg Park at Kellogg Boulevard and Cedar Street on Fridays, September 16, 23, and 30, 2016, from 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 2:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 2:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. on September 16, 23, and 30, 2016. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source from 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. on September 16, 23, and 30, 2016. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 7:00 p.m. on the dates of the event.
