1. Exterior - SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) - Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.-Found a red mercury PN #843ETN with a flat tire. Repair or remove the vehicle.

P. CLARKIN - WOH 1/28774

2. Interior - MN Stat. 299F.362 - Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-Hire a licensed electrician to replace the missing hard wired smoke detector on the main floor and check the basement detector as it tested with a very low tone.

# T. SWANSON - WOH /128808

3. Interior - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-The second floor egress window measured 19H x 20W.

P. CLARKIN - PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION TO NANCY

4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

5. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
