

SPRWS 1st Quarter Vehicle Accident Summary

Vehicle Accidents:

SPRWSVA 2017-01 Distribution 01/26/17: Distribution Division WUWI was driving Truck #591 (Hydrant Steamer Vehicle) WB on Taylor @ Howell and while looking for the worksite, struck a parked and unattended 1999 Chevrolet Extended Cab pickup truck near the NE portion of the intersection. The preliminary damage estimates submitted by the claimant range from \$14,200.00-\$15,500.00 (vehicle likely totaled), while damage to #591 will likely exceed \$10,000.00. No injuries were reported. No cell phone use prior to accident.

The employee completed Defensive Driving on 02/23/17.

SPRWSVA 2017-02 Distribution 03/27/17 1:53 P.M: SPRWS WUWI was driving Pickup Truck #610 NB on Wabasha in the right lane at about 10 m.p.h., preparing to turn right/EB onto 7th Street when the driver struck the left rear quarter area of Vehicle #2, which was Parked/Unattended and then pushed #2 forward into the rear end of Vehicle #3 which was also parked and unattended. Vehicle #2 had moderate damage (\$4964.64) while vehicle #3 had light undisclosed damage. SPRWS vehicle had minor scratches not needing repair. SPPD police report stated that the SPRWS driver was not sure how the accident occurred. No cell phone use at time of accident.

Equipment Damage:

SPRWS Equipment Damage 2017-01 Distribution 03/11/17: SPRWS Backhoe T-86 was maneuvering inside the work area after unloading parts from Pickup Truck #567 and swung to turn and the boom/bucket struck the passenger door of #567, denting the door and cracking the window. The SPRWS Garage sent #567 out for repair of the window and door panel.
