## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

### Sound Level Variance for an Outdoor Event Oxford Community Center Football Field

TO: Summit-University Planning Council

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

#### **Description of Variance:**

**Location:** Two Eid Prayer Services will be located outdoors at the Oxford Community Center Football Field, 270 Lexington Parkway North

**Noise Source:** Tawfiq Islamic Center has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide announcements and prayer for two occasions for Annual Eid Prayer Services at the Oxford Community Center Football Field, 270 Lexington Parkway North. The first occasion Eid Prayer Service is to be held on Monday, July 28<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. The second occasion Eid Prayer Service is to be held on Sunday, October 5<sup>th</sup> or Monday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014, also from 7:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. for the first occasion Eid Prayer Service on Monday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014 or Tuesday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014, and for the second occasion Eid Prayer Service on Sunday, October 5<sup>th</sup> or Monday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 75 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for prayer and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:30 a.m. on the date of the event.
