CORRECTION NOTICE - RE-INSPECTION COMPLAINT

Dear Property Representative:

A re-inspection was made on your building on June 12, 2024, in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on or after July 22, 2024.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Throughout SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame. -Multiple window frames boards are water damaged, deteriorating, and in disrepair repair or replace trim boards
- 2. Exterior Throughout SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) -All screens shall be maintained in a professional state of maintenance and repair. -Repair or replace damaged and missing screens
- 3. Exterior Walls SPLC 34.09 (1)(2)(a), 34.33 (1)(b) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. -Trim boards along roof and front facia boards chipped and peeling paint, boards are water damaged or missing repair or replace boards

4. MSBC - Section 1300.0120 Part 1 - Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit. -Windows being replaced - no permit on file - permit shall be pulled, work inspected, and the permit closed
