Dear Mr. Ryan:

This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that a variance be issued to allow you to complete the milling and paving work related to the Central Corridor Light Rail project along University Avenue West from Emerald Street to Rice Street from May 8 to May 22, 2014. The variance will be for the daytime hours of 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM for the primary work of pavement milling and nighttime hours of 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM for the primary work of paving (overlay).

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **May 7, 2014, 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.
