I live at 168 E6th St in Saint Paul , which lies within an area affected by the sound level variance requests from:

Lowertown Sounds 2019

and

Market & Music Wednesdays at Securian Financial.

Although I am in favor of music (preferably "good" music) gracing our public spaces, I am not in favor of loud music of any kind, any where.

A sound level of 85 dBA and upward, at any distance is harmful and can rapidly injure one's hearing apparatus.

Therefore, I am objecting to the proposed sound level variance of 90 dBA. Instead, I am asking that the maximum sound level be kept at or below 80 dBA at any distance from the source of the sound.
