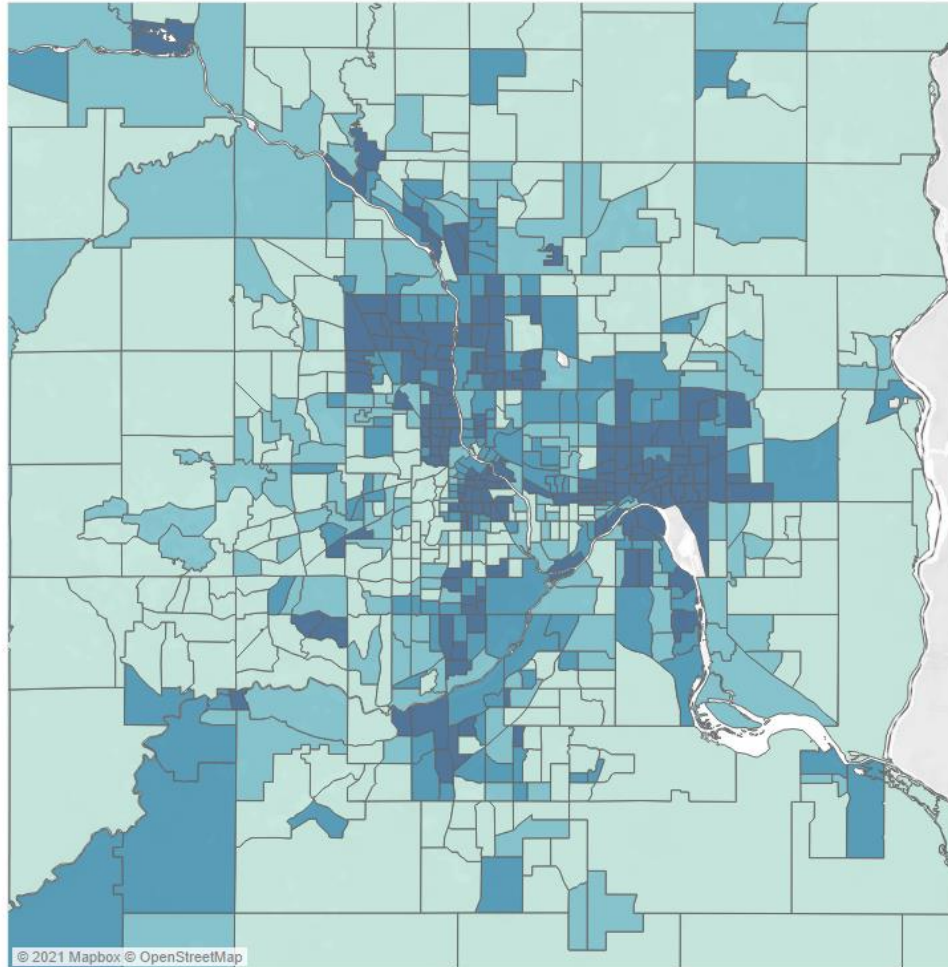


Fairgrounds vaccine site (starts April 14)

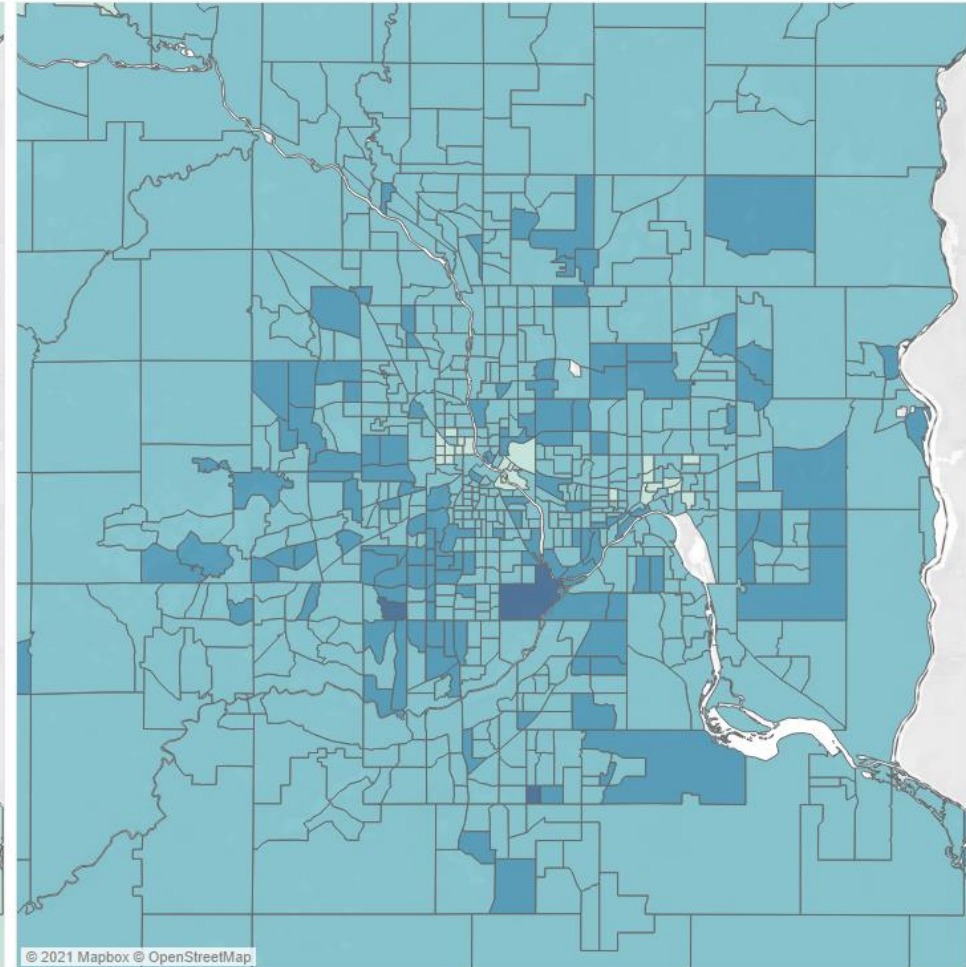
- Focus of this FEMA/State community vaccination center is to provide no barrier vaccination opportunities for Minnesotans.
- Goal: Vaccinate 105,000/84,000 Minnesotans in priority zip codes over 8 weeks
- Within this area: 96,361 residents are already signed up via Minnesota Vaccine Connector

Post vaccine life

Two weeks after your single dose of Johnson/Johnson & Janssen...

Two weeks after your second dose of Pfizer (Day 1 = first dose, Day 21 = second dose, Day 35 = two weeks after second dose)

Two weeks after your second dose of Moderna (Day 1 = first dose, Day 28 = second dose, Day 42 = two weeks after second dose)

You can:

- Visit with other fully vaccinated people without a mask!
- Visit with one household who is not vaccinated but not at severe risk (no elders, for example)
- Travel within the US without testing before or after
- Travel outside the US without testing beforehand (varies on the country)
- Return from international travel without quarantining afterwards

Testing and other precautions

- The state's testing site at Roy Wilkin continues to offer saliva testing 7 days a week.
- To schedule an appointment: mncovidtestingappt.as.me
- Consider ordering free at home testing kits for the summer months!
- Keep your distance, wear a mask, wash your hands. Do not travel unnecessarily.
